### Forklaring på EDIT CODES.

Edit codes are used to define the type of data held in a field, i.e. whether it is numeric, a date, alphabetic, etc.

An edit code is specified for each of the following types of data:

- A Data Dictionary item
- A Variable
- A Range
- A Screen field
- A Report field

The following table lists the various edit codes available in TODAY. It lists, for each code, the type of field that the code defines and the type of data that can be held in the field:

<u>Edit code</u>	<u>Type of Field</u>	<u>Allowable values</u>
U	Unspecified	Any printable characters
X	Alpha-numeric	Any printable characters
A	Alphabetic	A -> Z, a -> z, 'space'
L	Alpha-numeric with letters shifted to upper case.	As for 'X' edit code
N	Unsigned Number	0 -> 9, 'decimal point'
S	Signed Number	As for 'N' edit code but with an optional sign ('-').
Q	Question	Y or N
D	Date	Entered in sequence defined by Date Format Code.
T	Current Date	Same as 'D' but defaults to the current date.
C	Modulus 11	Any printable characters with the LAST one being the check digit. See Appendix H.
K	Key Format	A -> Z, a -> z, 0 -> 9, '_'
P	Password	Same as 'X' edit code but the characters are not echoed on entry.
