Australia

Social capital

putnam: A large number of others have been recoded
help: A large number of others have been recoded

Background

age: 65+ estimated with real age distribution from Australian Bureau of Statistics
edu_length: Please note that some respondents have unusually long educations (up to 88 years).
This is due to the fact that training undertaken as part of jobs has been included
inc_dol: We have yearly income so the income variable is divided by 12. Average exchange
rate for September 2004: 1 Australian dollar = 0,70145 USD
capital: The 5 cities with more than 1.000.000 residents. That is Sydney, Melbourne, Brisbane,
Adelaide and Perth.

Chile

social_p: Based on 'Situacion ocupacional' and 'Razon de no trabajo ni busqueda'
inc_dol: Average exchange rate for August-September 2003: 1 Chilean dollar = 0,00145 USD
capital: 'metropolitan area' on 'region'
rural: 'rural' on 'area'

Frequencies: some respondents has answered both week, month and year - the lowest
yearly frequency is chosen
help: A recoding has taken place. If a respondent has answered two categories which has
been putted into one it is registered as a dummy for the new variable but counted twice

edu_high: 'finished university studies' + 'postgraduate studies' on 'PC'
social_p: based on 'PDR'

inc_dol: This variable is not available for Costa Rica as we only have data for household income and these are not comparable to individual income.

inc_rel: Notice this is relative household income

capital: 'country's capital' on 'LOCA'

rural: 'rural area' on 'LOCA'

Denmark

putnam: 'p_farmer' to 'p_other' are dummy variables meaning that we don't know if a person is a member of more than one of each type of organisation
This means that in 'num_org' we have the number of types of organisations
A recoding has taken place. 'p_ngo' is no longer a dummy variable

help: A recoding has taken place. If a respondent has answered two categories which has been putted into one it is registered as a dummy for the new variable but counted twice in 'num_help'

Background

age: We only have the age in categories. The average age in each category has been estimated using Statistic Denmark's data for citizen age.

edu_leng: The years of schooling has been estimated from the education category according to the following:
'No further education' = 9 years
'Vocational education' = 13 years
'Short further education' = 14 years
'Medium long further education' = 16 years
'Long further education' = 18 years

edu_high: 'Long further education' on spm 60 'Longest finished education'

inc_dol: Asked what income group respondent belong to. It is yearly income so numbers are divided by 12. Notice it is the before tax income
Average exchange rate for April 2001: 1 kr. = 0,11970 USD

capital: 'Storkøbenhavn' on 'Geografi'

edu_leng: some of the respondents answer the length of only the last education

edu_high: 'Universidad completa' + 'postgrado' + 'tecnico artesanal' on 'nivel de educacion'

social_p: based on 'posicion social'
inc_dol: reported in dollars
capital: 'Quito' on 'Ciudad'
rural: 'area rural' on 'residencia'

Estonia

edu_leng: The years of schooling has been estimated from the education category according to the following:
Elementary education = 3
Primary education = 8
Secondary education = 10
Vocational education = 11
College/university education = 15
edu_high: 'College/university education' on 'x5 your education'
social_p: 12 respondents say other to the original social position question – they are coded as not working for other reasons
inc_dol: Asked: How big was your personal income last month?
Monthly income in US dollars - average exchange rate for February 2002: 1 EEK = 0,05562 USD
capital: 'capital' on 'type of settlement'
rural: 'village' on 'type of settlement'

Hong Kong

help: 11 categories of others have been recoded

age: Note no one is older than 54
inc_dol: Average exchange rate for September 2004: 1 Hong Kong Dollar = 0,12841 USD

Iceland

Social capital

help: A recoding has taken place. If a respondent has answered two categories which has been putted into one it is registered as a dummy for the new variable but counted twice in num_help
6 respondents have mentioned 4 helpers. Because the maximum number of helpers one can mention in other countries is 3, 4 is recoded to 3.

edu_high: 'University degree - Masters degree or more' on 'education'
social_p: Notice: The data from Iceland only allows us to distinguish between working, student and no answer. A category called home/invalid/unempl./pens. is set missing. Based on Occupation-Social position
inc_dol: monthly per capita income
One respondent say 1.000.000 one say 9.000.000. They are both set missing. We use the exact income if we got it. Otherwise we have used the category variable for income using the average income for those who have reported both. Average exchange rate for April 2003: 1 = 0,01304 USD
inc_rel: same as inc_dol
capital: 'Reykjavik' on regions
rural: 'village (less than 1.000 inhabitants)' + 'rural' on type of population center

Note lower age limit for respondents is 15

putnam: Water/Waste has been seen as an environmental organisation so they have been recoded to NGO.

help: 3 categories of others have been recoded. One person mention 4 helpers => sat to 3 in num_help

c_voted: -7 means that person is below 18 so person are not allowed to vote

inc_rel: Based on household income since personal income has a lot of missing

Slovenia

age: Estimated from year of birth. It is the age of December 31. 2000 since the survey has taken place June 2001

edu_high: 'high school, university'

inc_dol: Asked: Do you receive monthly income? If yes, what was your last income?
Last month income in US dollars - average exchange rate for June 2001: 1 = 0,00393 USD

capital: 'ljubljan' on 'tipnas'

rural: 'house, small village with up to 500 inhabitants'
